PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF THE MEMORANDUM

1. Setting the parameters of further cooperation in the field of improving air quality and sharing good practice in the TRITIA region among the cities of Rybnik, Opava, Žilina, Opole, and Ostrava in connection with the implementation of the project CE1101, UNIFORM APPROACH TO THE AIR POLLUTION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR FUNCTIONAL URBAN AREAS IN TRITIA REGION / AIR TRITIA co-financed by the Interreg CENTRAL EUROPE Programme (hereinafter „project CE1101 AIR TRITIA“).

III

RULES AND PRINCIPLES OF COOPERATION

1. Following the ongoing cooperation of the above-mentioned cities within the project CE1101 AIR TRITIA the cooperation will continue even after end of this project. For the purpose of fulfilling the aim and scope of the Memorandum, the representatives of the Contracting Parties shall cooperate. On the part of cities, these will be representatives of the city management or other representatives of elected bodies, heads of departments and other employees of departments of the municipal authority.
2. The Parties shall provide each other with materials relating to the issue of improving air quality.
3. Meetings of representatives of all Contracting Parties shall be held once a year at least to address the issue of improving air quality; if necessary, meetings shall be held more frequently and shall be convened on an ad hoc basis. During the meetings, the Parties will exchange all relevant information on developments in the field of air quality improvement, as well as on the findings of projects in the field of air quality improvement, and will share examples of good practice in connection to the outputs created in the project CE1101, AIR TRITIA.

IV

FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The Memorandum shall enter into force and shall take effect on the date of signature by all Parties and shall be concluded for a definite period till December 31st 2025. In case the Contracting Parties wish to extend and continue the cooperation, it is agreed that the cooperation may be extended by an amendment to the Memorandum.
2. The Contracting Parties agree that the Memorandum may be published in the Register of Contracts, which is established in the Czech Republic according to Act No. 340/2015 Coll., on Special Conditions for the Effectiveness of Certain Contracts, the Disclosure of These Contracts and the Register of Contracts (Act on the Register of Contracts).
3. Any changes to the Memorandum shall only be made by written amendments signed by all authorized representatives of the Contracting Parties.
4. The Memorandum shall be drawn up in five copies, each of which shall be valid as an original. Each Contracting Party shall receive one copy.
5. The Contracting Parties declare that they have read the Memorandum, fully understand its content and that its content expresses their real, sincere and free will. They confirm this with their signatures below.
